

TEACHING PHILOSOPHY

PURPOSE

Our objective is to provide each camper with a greater understanding of the fundamentals of both offensive and defensive basketball. This will be accomplished by enthusiastically emphasizing these fundamentals on an individual basis.

INSTRUCTIONAL EMPHASIS

Shooting-Special emphasis will be placed on shooting, including teaching proper mechanics.

Offensive Fundamentals-Individual and 3-on-3 concepts will be covered; ball-handling, passing, moving without the ball, individual moves, screening, using screens, posting, transition, footwork and offensive rebounding.

Terminology-Another special part of camp will be devoted to teaching important terms, rules, and concepts of the game.

LECTURES

Local college and high school coaches will speak about mental and moral aspects of the game. Local college players will form a roundtable to discuss, "What it takes to get where I am", and "What it's like to play college basketball."



Our individual camp is scheduled from 9:00 am - 3:30 pm. Since this is only a day camp, housing is not provided but numerous campers commute and car pool from many of the surrounding areas.
