◀ Red-hot Lady Quakers Top Ohio Northern

Wilmington College shot a season-high 56 percent from the field en route to a 79-55 romp over Ohio Northern in Ohio Athletic Conference women's basketball action at Fred Raizk Arena.

Wilmington used a 16-4 spurt early in the game to set the tone. In the opening frame, Wilmington connected on 59 percent of its field goal attempts and 6 of 8 shots from beyond the arc. At the half, the Lady Quakers held a 41-22 advantage.

The Polar Bears did not offer a serious threat in the second half as Wilmington's advantage grew to as many as 26 points.

Wilmington was led by Andrea Anderson, who scored career-high 15 points on 5 of 5 shooting. The junior connected on all three of her 3-point attempts and was 2-for-2 at the free throw line. Anderson was part of a 44-point performance by Wilmington's non-starters.

Kortney Kin scored 14 points, 10 coming in the first half. Claire Brown added 10 points. Allie Meranda scored nine points while Ki Godfrey and Olivia Waters added eight apiece. Waters also pulled down six rebounds and blocked season-high four shots.

For the game, Wilmington claimed 42 rebounds to 32 for Ohio Northern.

Joanna Snyder was the lone Polar Bear in double figures, finishing with 11.
